Each 5 ml contains extracts of *Vitis vinifera* 0.72 gm, *Cinnamomum zeylanicum* 13.87 mg, *Amomum subulatum* 13.87 mg, *Cinnamomum tamala* 13.87 mg, *Mesua ferrea* 13.87 mg, *Aglaia roxburghiana* 13.87 mg, *Piper longum* 13.87 mg, *Embelia ribes* 13.87 mg, *Piper nigrum* 13.87 mg & *Woodfordia fruticosa* 13.87 mg and other ingredients with excipients as required.

Description

Asmarid[®] (Mohadraksharista) syrup is a justified combination of herbs where are used to treat asthma, bronchitis, tuberculosis, cough, chest pain & other respiratory tract infection. It is effective, safe and well tolerate. Both male & female patients of all ages can use it.

Pharmacology

Vitis vinifera: It contains flavonoids, tannin, tartaric acid, malic acid, citric acid, oxalic acid which shows positive effects against peripheral venous insufficiency, as an antioxidant effects. It is useful in cough, catarrh, thirst, hoarseness & chronic bronchitis. It is astringent & useful in throat affections.

Cinnamomum zeylanicum: It contains volatile oil, mucilage, calcium oxalate, sugar & starch. It is aromatic, astringent, stimulant & carminative. It has antibacterial and antiseptic properties & used as antiinflammatory agent.

Amomum subulatum: It contains volatile oil, resin, fixed oil, starch and calcium oxalate. The containing essential oil of *Amomum subulatum* has antibacterial & antimycotic properties. It is stimulant, stomachic, carminative & used as flavoring agent.

Mesua ferrea: It contains mesuagin, essential oil, mesuol, mesuone and shell oils & has astringent & aromatic properties. It has antibiotic activity & used in cough attended with expectorant.

Piper longum: It contains piperine, piperlonguminine, pipartine, piperlongumine, volatile oil, resin & sesamine. It is analgesic, carminative & general tonic and used for respiratory tract like cough, bronchitis, asthma & cold.

Embelia ribes: It contains embelin, vilangin, christembine, tannins and volatile oil. It has astringent, carminative, stimulant, alterative and tonic properties & used to cure cough & chest complaints.

Piper nigrum: It contains the alkaloids piperine, chavicine, piperidine & piperetine. It also contains thiamine, riboflavin, nicotinic acid, ascorbic acid & carotene. It is aromatic, stimulant and carminative & used as a local application for relaxed for sore throat.

Woodfordia fruticosa: It contains ellagic acid, B-sitosterol & octacosanol. It is cooling, stimulant, astringent and used in disorders of mucous membrane & safe stimulant in pregnancy.

Indications

Asthma, Bronchitis, Tuberculosis, Cough & Chest pain

Dosage & Administration

Route of administration: Oral.

Adult: 2-4 teaspoonful 2 times daily after meal
