Only for the use of animals

Composition

Each vial contains Procaine Penicillin BP 30,00,000 Units & Benzyl Penicillin Sodium BP 10,00,000 Units.

Pharmacology

Procaine Penicillin & Benzyl Penicillin Sodium inhibits cell wall synthesis of bacteria by inhibiting transpeptidase enzyme.

Indications

Combipen Vet® 40 Lacs is indicated for the prevention & treatment of Anthrax, Black quarter, Actinomycosis, Calf diphtheria, Foot rot, Malignant edema, Pneumonia, Navel ill, Tetanus, Wounds, Burns, Mastitis, Metritis & secondary bacterial infection etc.

Dosage & administration

Route of administration: IM

For deep intramuscular injection only

Combinen Vet® 40 Lacs: 8.4 ml water for injection to be added to the powder supplied in vial of Combinen Vet 40 Lacs to prepare 10 ml suspension & should be administered into deep intramuscular region as following dosage guide line-

Cattle/Buffalo/Horse- 10 ml/200 kg body weight.

Goat/Sheep/Dog/Cat/Other small animals- 1 ml/20 kg body weight.

Combinen Vet 40 Lacs injection should be administered every 24 hours & to be continued for further 1-2 days after subsided of the diseased symptoms.

Shake well before use.

Or, as directed by the Registered Veterinary Physician.

Contraindication

Contraindicated to the animals hypersensitive to penicillin.

Warning and precaution

If hypersensitivity reaction occurs, contact immediately to the registered Veterinary physician.

Side effects

Common side effects: Swelling & redness at the site of injection may occur but usually resolve after cessation of therapy. **Rare side effects:** Pain, Numb, Diarrhea etc. may be seen.

Use in pregnancy & lactation

Safe for use in pregnancy & lactating animal. However, risk & necessity should be considered during administration in pregnant & lactating animal.

Drug interaction

With medicine: Procaine Penicillin & Benzyl Penicillin Sodium may inactivate aminoglycosides.

With food & others: Not known.

Overdose

In lactating animals higher dosage rate has the disadvantage of increasing penicillin residues in milk.

Withdrawal time

Meat- Meat must not be consumed up to 6 days after administration of this medicine. Milk- Milk must not be consumed up to 3 days after administration of this medicine.

Storage

Store below 30° C temperature & dry place, protected from light.

Keep all medicines out of reach of children.

Packing

Combinen Vet® 40 lacs: Each box contains 1 vial filled with powder and one ampoule of 10 ml water for injection.



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
