

Fluticasone Furoate INN, Umeclidinium Bromide INN and Vilanterol Trifenatate INN (Rotacap)

Composition

Trihale 100: Each capsule contains Fluticasone Furoate INN 100 mcg, Umeclidinium Bromide INN equivalent to 62.5 mcg of Umeclidinium and Vilanterol Trifenatate INN equivalent to 25 mcg of Vilanterol.

Trihale 200: Each capsule contains Fluticasone Furoate INN 200 mcg, Umeclidinium Bromide INN equivalent to 62.5 mcg of Umeclidinium and Vilanterol Trifenatate INN equivalent to 25 mcg of Vilanterol.

Pharmacology

Trihale represent 3 different classes of medications (an Inhaled Corticosteroid, a LAMA, and a LABA), each having different effects. Fluticasone Furoate is a synthetic trifluorinated corticosteroid with potent anti-inflammatory activity. Umeclidinium is a long-acting muscarinic antagonist (LAMA). In the airways, it exhibits pharmacological effects through inhibition of M3 receptor at the smooth muscle leading to bronchodilation. Vilanterol is a LABA (Long Acting Beta₂ Agonist) which relaxes airway smooth muscle by stimulating β₂-adrenergic receptors causing bronchodilation.

Indication

Trihale is indicated for the maintenance treatment of patients with Asthma & Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), including chronic bronchitis and/or emphysema.

Dosage and Administration

Route of Administration: Inhalation Capsule
The capsules are intended for use with Easyhaler. While using with the Easyhaler, the capsules will be pierced and will be ready to use.

18 years and older

Trihale 100: One Rotacap once daily.

Trihale 200: One Rotacap once daily.

Trihale should be used at the same time every day. Do not use Trihale more than 1 time in every 24 hours

OR AS DIRECTED BY THE PHYSICIAN.

Contraindication

The use of **Trihale** is contraindicated in:

- · Patients with severe hypersensitivity to milk proteins.
- Those who have demonstrated hypersensitivity to Fluticasone Furoate, Umeclidinium, Vilanterol or any of the excipients.

Warning and Precautions

Patients should be instructed in the proper use of **Easyhaler** to ensure that the drug reaches

the target areas within the lungs. A capsule should only be instructed into the **Easyhaler** immediately prior to use. It may be helpful to rinse out the mouth with water immediately after inhalation.

Trihale should not be initiated in patients during rapidly deteriorating or potentially life-threatening episodes of COPD. Patients who have been taking oral or inhaled, short-acting beta,-agonists on a regular basis (e.g., 4 times a day) should be instructed to discontinue the regular use of these drugs after starting of Trihale.

Headache, Nausea, Vomiting, Diarrhea, Back pain, Cough, Taste disturbance, Mouth and/or throat pain.

Use in Pregnancy and Lactation

There are insufficient data on the use of **Trihale** in pregnant women. There is no information of **Trihale** presence in human milk and the effects on the breastfed child.

Use in Children and Adolescents

Trihale is not indicated for children. The safety and efficacy in pediatric patients have not been established. Trihale is not indicated under 18 years of age.

NInhibitors of Cytochrome P450 3A4, Monoamine Oxidase Inhibitors and Tricyclic Antidepressants, Beta-adrenergic Receptor Blocking Agents, Non-Potassium-Sparing Diuretics and Anticholinergics.

Overdose

Overdose symptoms may include chest pain, fast heart rate, and feeling shaky or short of breath

Storage

Store below 25°C temperature & dry place, protected from light.

Keep all medicines out of reach of children.

Trihale 100: Each box contains 1X10 capsules in Alu-Alu blister for use with Easyhaler device. Trihale 100: Each box contains 3X10 capsules in Alu-Alu blister with free Easyhaler.

Trihale 200: Each box contains 1X10 capsules in Alu-Alu blister for use with Easyhaler device.

Trihale 200: Each box contains 3X10 capsules in Alu-Alu blister with free Easyhaler.

Pharmaceutical Precautions

- · Rotacap is to be used through Easyhaler.
- Rotacap is not to be swallowed.
- · Do not exceed the recommended dose.
- · Insert the Rotacap in the Easyhaler just prior to use, as Rotacap exposed to moisture may not be pierced easily. 1794/02
